Master Box's figures get better with each release and they were pretty damn good to begin with. This time we have a set of five 1:35 WW2 British/Commonwealth AFV crewmen (is that Monty with a cup of cha?) plus a camel and rider in local (North African?) garb. The figures are very appealing; they carry excellent detail and are sculpted in useful poses, perfect to go with the happily expanding line of WW2 British vehicles appropriate to tropical theatres of operation. The camel is just about the best representation we've seen on the beast in 1:35 and actually looks like a camel, rather than one of those CGI critters from Star Wars...

In the next release, we have six extremely well done 1:32 figures of famous WW2 pilots from various nations; Lidia Litviak, Saburo Sakai, Richard 'Dick' Bong, Werner Mölders, James 'Johnnie' Johnson and Albert Marcel. All are very well done and a booklet is included in the box giving some history to each pilot, a nice touch. The only question mark here is that the box-art shows Johnson wearing his RAF blue-grey uniform, Mae West, flying helmet with his rather lovely black Labrador at his side, however in the kit he is wearing a leather jacket and no dog! Still a nice set though and a great idea. MN
